

OBITUARY

Emma Charlotte Rohlwing was born in Dupage county, Ill. Dec. 8, 1869 and died in Minneapolis, June 24, 1920, being 50 years 6 months and 16 days old at the time of her death.

When 6 years of age she moved with her parents to a farm near Waverly, Iowa.

In 1893 she was united in marriage to H.G. Rohlwing, living in Waverly until 1904 when they moved to Cooperstown, N.D. living on a farm until the fall of 1911, when they moved on a farm three miles south of Hannaford.

In 1918 they retired from the farm moving to Hannaford, the place of their present family home.

Mrs. Rohlwing was confirmed in the Lutheran church when about 14 of age.

She was in failing health for about three years suffering a great deal the last year of her life. She realized for some time that the end was near and was ready and willing to go.

She leaves a husband, two sons and a large circle of friends to mourn her departure.

Carl, the elder son, resides in Modeste, California, Raymond, the younger, in Hannaford.
