

Mrs. L. O. Stai

Mrs. L. O. Stai died at her home in Sverdrup township, Thursday, November 21, after an illness of about six months from tuberculosis. One daughter, Lena, died in March and another daughter, Olga, died in April, from the same cause, and the grief incident to the death of her two girls contributed in a large measure to the illness of the mother.

Mrs. Stai was born in Norway 66 years ago. She was married to Mr. L. O. Stai in Goodhue county, Minn., and they came to Griggs county in 1888. Three children were born to them, Bertha, who died 18 years ago, of tuberculosis, and Olga and Lina, who preceded their mother to the Great Beyond as above stated.

She is survived by her husband, and brothers and sisters-in-law as follows: Ed Stai, of Hannaford; C. C. Nolen, Dazey; Mrs. Skjonsberg, of Sisseton, S. D., and Mrs. Simon Ouren and Mrs. Henry Gullickson, of Sverdrup.

Funeral services were held Sunday afternoon, November 24, at the Union church, Rev. Sigurd Olsen officiating. The services were largely attended by old friends and neighbors and there were numerous floral offerings. Interment was made in the Union cemetery.

Mrs. Stai was another pioneer of Griggs county who has gone to her eternal rest, and her many friends and neighbors sincerely regret her passing. Mr. Stai, the husband, who has been bereaved by the loss of daughters and wife all in a few brief months, is grief stricken and the deep sympathy of the entire community goes out to him.—Sentinel-Courier.
