

Obituary

Anna Thompson died at the home of her son Martin, south of Sutton, at 12 o'clock on Saturday, Dec. 15, at the age of 83 years. Deceased was born in Elvindvik, Bergen, Norway, and came with her husband to Osseo, Wis., where they located on a homestead in 1872. Thomas Thompson, her husband, died thirteen years ago, and in 1907 she came to Griggs county to make her home with her son. She has been confined to her bed a large portion of the time since coming here.

Deceased is survived by four children, Martin, of Sutton, Lina, of Fargo, and Mrs. Anna Jaeger and Mrs. Mathilde Sorenson of Eau Claire, Wis.

The funeral was held from the home on Tuesday, Dec. 18, with scripture reading and prayer, and after services in the Mabel church, interment was made in Mabel cemetery, Rev. P. A. Thoreson officiating.
