

Ole H. Westley Died Friday, April 19

Ole H. Westley, 83 years and 28 days old, passed away at his home in Sverdrup, on Friday, April 19th, death resulting from feebleness due to old age.

Deceased was born in Norway on March 22, 1835, and emigrated to America in 1881, settling on a home stead in Sverdrup township, where he continually resided until his death.

He is survived by his wife, with whom he has lived for over 51 years, and eight children, O. M. and O. C. Westley, of Hannaford; Mrs. Chr. Ashland, of Fargo; Hans and O. B. Westley, of Sverdrup; Mrs. Chr. Wuffestad, of Sverdrup; Lieut. M. D. Westley, now at Ft. Riley, Kansas, and Miss Anna Westley of Minneapolis, all of whom were present at the funeral.

Funeral services were held at the Westley church on Monday, April 22, at 2 p. m. Revs. Njust, Eidsaa and Lunde officiating, and interment was made in the Westley cemetery. The services were largely attended by old friends and neighbors of long standing, and at the service Miss Anna Lunde sang beautifully, "Abide with Me." Miss Elise Brosten presided at the piano.

Deceased was one of the earliest pioneers of the county, and his passing is deeply mourned by a host of friends whose respect and esteem he held throughout a long and useful life.
