

**Order Hearing Petition for
Sale of Land
State of North Dakota,**

On reading and filing the petition
of Alfred Gustafson, Administrator,
setting forth the amount of personal
estate that has come to his hands,
and the disposition thereof, the
amount of debts outstanding against
said deceased, and the expenses of
administration, a description of all
the real estate of which said deceas-
ed died seized, and the condition and
value of the respective portion there-
of; and praying that license be to
him granted to sell the following
described land belonging to the es-
tate of said John Brekke, deceased,
to-wit: Lots 1 to 8 inclusive in
Block 10, Langdon's Second Addi-
tion to Hannaford; northeast quart-
er of southeast quarter, southeast
quarter of northeast quarter, south
half of northwest quarter and lots
one, two three and four in Section
Four (4) Township One Hundred
and Forty-four (144) north, Range
Fifty-nine (59) West, all in Griggs
County, North Dakota.

And it appearing by said petition,
that there is not sufficient money or
personal estate in the hands of said
administrator to pay said debts and
expenses and that it is necessary, in
order to pay the same, to sell said
real estate:

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED,
That the said petition be heard and
considered by the Judge of the
County Court of the said County of
Griggs at the court rooms of said
Court, in the County Court House, in
the City of Cooperstown in said
County, on the 13th day of January,
A. D., 1919, at one o'clock in the
afternoon of said day.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that
all persons interested in said estate,
appear before the Judge of this
Court at said time and place, and
then and there show cause, if any
there be, why said petition should
not be granted.
