

We have four mild-cases of Spanish influenza in the county now and the Board of Health wishes the people to co-operate with them and try to prevent an epidemic of this disease. Report all cases to Dr. Almklov. Keep all children away from school or public places when sick. Don't allow any sick person to come to your home—if you are sick don't go to the home of anyone else. Put the sick person to bed at once and keep him or her there until well, as the complications are more dangerous than the disease. Pneumonia, pleurisy and consumption are the complications. Be careful.—Dr. L. Almklov, Supt. County Board of Health.
