

Memorial services were held last Sunday afternoon in the Presbyterian Church in honor of Ralph Mann, who was a member of the "Lost Battalion" and was killed in action in the Argonne. A quartette composed of Misses Anna and Cora Lunde, Dr. O. H. Hoffman and C. Reite sang; there were addresses by Rev. J. C. Wilson and Rev. P. A. Thoreson, and testimonials by some of the members of the congregation who knew the young man in whose honor the services were held.
