

The action of United States against F. A. Peverett, who was recently arrested at Sanborn, for an alleged violation of the espionage act passed by Congress, June 15th, 1917, was dismissed last week in U. S. Commissioner Zabel's Court upon motion of the Government, for the reason that the grand jury, which had just adjourned and to whose attention the case was brought pending the hearing before the Commissioner, refused to indict Mr. Peverett, thereby vindicating him from the charges preferred against him.
