The action of United States against F. A. Peverett. who was recenty arrested at Sanborn, for an al- n leged violation of the espionage act passed by Congress. June 15th, 1917. dismissed last week in U.S. •1 Commissioner Zabel's Court upon F motion of the Government, for the reason that the grand jury, which had just adjourned and to whose attention the case was brought pending the hearing before the Commissioner, refused to indict Mr. Peverett. thereby vindicating him from the charges preferred against him.
