

Captain M. D. Westley, who just returned home from France, told of his war experiences in the Presbyterian church last Sunday evening. Dr. Westley has had over six months of active service in France and most of that time was spent as near the front lines as medical officers are ever sent. Much of the time he was within range of the German artillery and has seen men killed within about one hundred feet from where he was working. His unit has handled as many as 800 cases in one night, so it may be imagined that he has experienced some of the horrors of war. Captain Westley will tell more of what he has seen of the war at the basket social in Jackson's Hall on Thursday evening of this week.
