

The result in Ohio seems to have been as much a surprise to the Democrats as to the Republicans. It was a good deal of a "scratch."

The effort to show that it wasn't much of a shower, that it cannot have any bearing upon national politics, and that it is the mere result of a local squabble over temperance and other side issues, sounds too much like whistling in a church-yard. Better come out and acknowledge the corn. It was a defeat—and a defeat, too, which is all the more poignant because it was unexpected. And the Democrats, too, must not crow too much, nor magnify the political importance of their victory. They won when they did not expect to, and snatched success from the very cup of despair. Both sides had better accept the result with as little talk as possible and each seek to profit by the lesson it teaches in numerous directions.
