

Proceedings of County Commissioners.

Met October 3, 1884, at 10 a. m.
Present, R. C. Cooper,
Adjourned until October 4, 1884, at 9 a. m.

Convened October 4, 1884, at 9 a. m.
Present, Messrs. Rukke and Cooper,
Commissioner Cooper presiding.

On motion ordered that the county be redivided into voting precincts as follows, viz:

Voting precinct No. 1 shall comprise all of townships 147 and 148, ranges 58 and 59. Polling place at the house of Isaac E. Mills on sec. 36, tp 148, range 59.

Voting precinct No. 2 shall comprise all of townships 147 and 148, ranges 60 and 61. Polling place at the school house on section 16, township 148, range 60.

Voting precinct No. 3 shall comprise all of township 146, ranges 60 and 61 and the north half of township 145, ranges 60 and 61. Polling place at the house of David Nicolls on section 6, township 145, range 60.

Voting precinct No. 4 shall comprise all that portion of township 146 and the north half of township 145, ranges 58 and 59, lying west of the Sheyenne river. Polling place at the county clerk's office in Cooperstown.

Voting precinct No. 5 shall comprise all that portion of township 146, range 58, which lies east of the Sheyenne river. Polling place at the Park Avenue hotel at Mardell.

Voting precinct No. 6 shall comprise all of townships 144 and 145, range 58, which lies east of the Sheyenne river. Polling place at the Gallatin postoffice.

Voting precinct No. 7 shall comprise all of townships 144 and the south half of township 145, range 59, and all that portion of township 144 and the south half of township 145, range 58, lying west of the Sheyenne river. Polling place at house of Nels Hemingson, on section 10, 144-59.

Voting precinct No. 8 shall comprise all of townships 144 and the south half of township 145, ranges 60 and 61. Polling place at the house of Peter Fiero.

On motion ordered that the following named persons be appointed judges of election for their respective precincts, viz:

First precinct, Rollef Berg, Frank Hunter, and Mark Sutherland.
Second precinct, A. D. Ellis, Benjamin F. Kuhns, and Joseph Buchheit.
Third precinct, John Nicolls, Wm. Kingsley and Lyman L. Lewis.
Fourth precinct, M. J. Davis, H. Retzlaff and Peter E. Nelson.
Fifth precinct, M. Robinson, O. Nelson, and Nels E. Nelson.
Sixth precinct, Alexander Saunders, John H. Atchison and C. H. Frost.
Seventh precinct, M. A. Ueland, F. Greenland and J. M. Freese.
Eighth precinct, J. G. White, Chas. H. Mosely and Nicolai Swenson.
