A Washington special says: An impression prevails among the democrats of prominence who are arriving here from the north, east and west, that there will not be much south in the cabinet of President Cleveland. It has already been asserted that the south will dominate as before the war. Cleveland has been put upon his guard by the declarations, and will profit by them.

The democratic party in its Chicago platform meant what it said and said what it meant, and will carry the provisions of that platform, which relates to the business interest of the country, into effect.
