CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS.

The following proposed amendments to the Constitution of North Dakota, having passed the Seventh Legis. lative Assembly, will be submitted to the Eighth Legis-lative Assembly for approval or rejection:

Subdivision five, Section two hundred and fifteen (215), of Article nineteen (19), of the Constitution of the state of North Dakota, is amended so as to read as follows:
