Facts.
 The British Medical Journal states that last January the Council of the British Medical Association through a committee among whom are Sir Lander Brunton, Sir Henry Thompson, Sir William Turner, Sir Victor Horsley and Professor G. Sims Woodhead, asked every registered physician in England, Scotland, Ireland and Wales to unite with them in signing a petition for the compulsory study of the laws of health including elementary instruction on the nature and effects of alcohol.

This petition has already been signed by nearly 15,000 practitioners in all parts of Great Britain. Recognizing the degeneracy and disease from the neglect and infraction of the elementary laws of hygiene, the petition also affirms the facts, that "much of the degeneracy disease and accident with which medical men are called upon to deal, is directly or indirectly due to the use of alcohol, and that a wide-spread ignorance prevails concerning not only the nature and properties of this substance, but also its effects on the body and mind." This seems like worthy endorsement of the American plan of Scientific Temperance Instruction, in the face of the elaborate and labored arguments of its opposers.
