PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO CONSTITUTION.
Be it Resolved by the house of representatives of the State of North Dakota, the Senate Concurring:
That the following amendment to the constitution of the state of North Dakota, adopted by the seventh legislative assembly of the state of North Dakota, and by it referred to the eighth legislative assembly of said state for approval, or rejection, is hereby agreed to, and such amendment shall be submitted to the qualified electors, to be approved or rejected, in accordance with the provisions of section 22 of the constitution of the state of North Dakota.
That section 17 of the constitution of the state of North Dakota be amended, by adding thereto and making part thereof, the following clause:
AMENDMENT.
The legislative assembly may further provide that grain grown within the state and held therein in elevators, warehouses and granaries may be taxed as a graded rate.
PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO CONSTITUTION.
Be it Resolved by the Senate, the House of Representatives Concurring:
That the following amendment to the constitution of the state of North Dakota, adopted by the seventh legislative assembly of the state of North Dakota, and by it referred to the eighth legislative assembly of said state for approval, or rejection, is hereby agreed to, and such amendment shall be submitted to the qualified electors, to be approved or rejected, in accordance with the provisions of section 22 of the constitution of the state of North Dakota.
That subdivision 3, of section 215 of the constitution of the state of North Dakota, be amended so as to read as follows:
AMENDMENT.
Eighth. A state hospital for the insane at the city at Jamestown, in the county of Stutsman. And the legislative assembly shall appropriate twenty thousand acres of the grant of lands made by the act of congress aforesaid for 'other educational and

charitable institutions,' to the benefit and for the endowment of said institution, and there shall be located at or near the city of Grafton, in the county of Walsh, an institution for the feeble minded, on the grounds purchased by the secretary of the interior for a penitentiary building.
