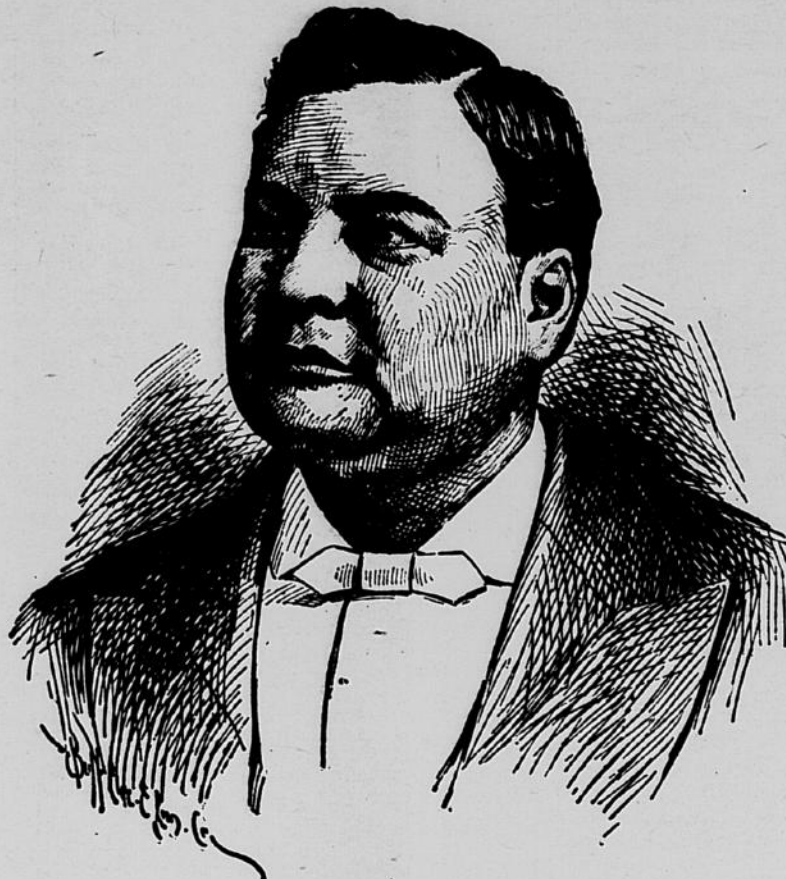

Notice of Lease of School and Institution Lands.

The school and institution lands not already leased, situated in Griggs county and State of North Dakota, will be offered for lease at public auction to the highest bidder at the court house in the village of Cooperstown in said county, commencing at eleven o'clock a. m. on Friday, March 24th, 1905. A complete list of the lands to be offered for lease has been filed with the county auditor, where the same can be inspected.

No bid will be entertained for less than 5 per cent. of the appraised value of cultivated lands and 1 per cent. of appraised value of uncultivated lands, and in no case will a bid be entertained for any quarter section at less than \$5 per year. Lands appraised at \$10 per acre or more will be leased for one year only. All uncultivated lands appraised at less than \$10 per acre will be leased for a term of five years.

The entire amount of first year's rent, together with fee of \$5 for five years lease and \$1.50 for one year lease, must be paid at the time of leasing. All deferred payment of rents must be paid on or before the sixth day of January in each year.
