MAKE MONEY



Ordinance in Regard to Sidewalks.

Upon motion the following ordinance in relation to sidewalks and the laying thereof was unanimously adopted:

It is hereby ordered that all sidewalks hereafter laid in the Village of Cooperstown be constructed of cement or stone unless by special permission of the board of trustees, which permission shall be by resolution of the said board of trustees duly adopted in a regular or special session; that said walks shall be laid upon a good and substantial foundation of sand and gravel of at least six inches in depth, and the outside of said walks shall in all cases, except on the north and west side of block seventy-three, the north and east side of block seventy-four, on the south and west side of block fifty-nine, be on a line ten feet from the outer line of the lots along which the same is laid; that along said aforesaid mentioned blocks on the north and south sides respectively, the outer line of said walks shall be twelve feet from the outer line of the lots along which the same is laid, and on the east and west side of said blocks as heretofore mentioned the outer line of said walks shall be ten feet from the outer line of said lots along which the same is laid, and built on an incline from the line of said lots to the water and that along said outer line along said last mentioned blocks there shall be constructed a curb of cement or stone set well into the ground so as to prevent the same from sagging or spreading out. That on the balance of said streets the curb shall be fifteen feet from the line of the lots and said last mentioned walks shall be at least four and one-half feet wide and all of said walks shall be laid under the supervision and direction of the village marshal or the board of trustees.
