New Railroad.

Cooperstown Will Probably Have an East and West Road Shortly.

New Extensions to be Made From Duluth to Thief River Falls and Carrington—Fargo May be Reached Later.

Duluth, Minn., Nov. 8.—It has been announced that the Duluth, South Shore & Atlantic railway would be built from this city to Thief River Falls next year, there connecting with the Soo, in order to bring the grain direct to the head of the lake, in place of taking it around through Minneapolis. The majority of the stock of this road is owned by the Canadian Pacific, the same as the Soo. Your correspondent is informed that the line will be built west next year, but in place of striking Thief River Falls, it will connect with the Soo about thirty or thirty-five miles south of that town and thus affording the eastern outlet.

There is another feature of this extension even more important to the people of the state of North Dakota. The road will be extended westerly from the point where it connects with the Soo, going to the south of Crookston, crossing the Red river at or near Belmont, and running nearly straight west to Carrington, where it will connect with the Soo, and afford an eastern outlet for the grain from north of that point. This line will be about midway between the main lines of the Great Northern and the Northern Pacific and is being run not only to give the outlet referred to but also to cut into the traffic of the roads mentioned to as great an extent as possible.

It can be stated on authority that the Soo will not build into either Grand Forks or Fargo the coming year, but steps may be started late in the summer to build into Fargo from the east.

The above appeared in the Fargo Forum recently and is of the greatest importance to the farmers of Griggs county. It means, if the Soo officials carry out their plans, that the people of this county will have a competing railroad running east and west within the next year or two that will give them a direct line to Duluth on which to ship their grain. The proposed line will therefore touch probably every county seat from Duluth and will of course reach Cooperstown. It will cause new towns to be built west of us and also east of us and for a time will cut off some of the town trade, but in the long run we shall get it back again as the country fills up. This has been the experience of other towns and will be ours. A competing line will be a great thing for all concerned and farmers all along the proposed line want to hold out all the inducements possible for this new line. It will mean dollars to them by getting cheaper freight rates and will give them better facilities for shipping.
