

None of them have made a habit of buying tickets, but they have all invested two or three times before. This time they chipped in one dollar apiece and bought four one-tenth tickets, three of which have proved blanks. They propose to put their money into a house and lot.

Charles E. Stange, stationer, Randolph street near Fort, who drew a share in the capital \$75,000 prize in the same lottery in 1882, said recently that both he and his partners in the venture. Philip W. Witzleben, clerk with R. G. Dun & Co., then invested for the first time. The lucky ticket was number \$5,003, of which they owned one fifth. They could not get their winnings through the banks, as the latter refused to handle lottery money, but the express company took their ticket down and brought the money back, \$15,000 in hard cash, for \$70. He was then clerk at Richmond, Backus & Co.'s, and went into his present business, while Witzleben invested in real estate. He still buys tickets occasionally, and won \$10 last year.
