Titles to Land in the Northwest.

Washington Special to the Boron Hearld;
Last October Secretary Teller decided that a
great number of eash entries of public lands
in Michigan, Minnesota, Wisconsin and other
Western states and territories were void.
These entries were made upon lands withdrawn from the public domain as railroad
land, and subsequently restored. Secretary
Teller held that as the lands thus restored,
were never offered for sale at public auction,
they cannot be entered by settlers under the
law until they have been so offered. The
decision created a great deal of consternation among cash entry men, and it is said
that thousands of acres of their lands have
been squatted upon by homesteaders. For
several days a delegation representing the
cash entries in the northern peninsula of Michigan have been here to consult with members
and senators as to the best method of legalizing
the sales. As a result Senator Palmer
introduced a bill in the senate to confirm the
titles of all who purchased in good faith. The
Michigan delegation in the house will hold a
meeting to devise ways and means for passing
favorable legislation through that end of the
capitol. It is expected that other states will be

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
