A Washington special says the bill which has passed both houses to repeal the pre-emption act contains a provision important to recent pre-emptors and those contemplating making pre-emption claims. This provision was inserted at the instance of Delegate Raymond of Dakota, and provides that the repeal shall not affect any valid rights heretofore acquired under the pre-emption laws, nor any bona fied claims lawfully initiated before the 1st day of July, 1885. The same reservation of the rights of bona fied claimants is incorporated in those sections of the bill repealing the timber-culture and desert-land acts.—Pioneer Press.

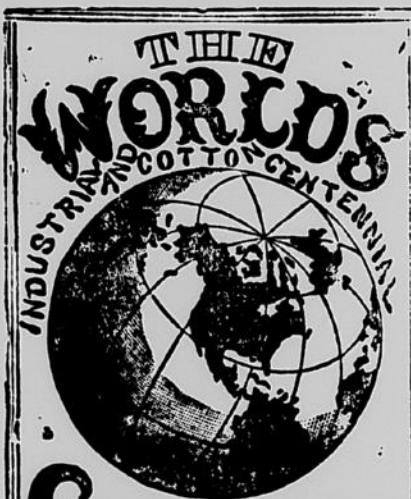
