In a four ounce glove fight at Sportsman's Park, New Orleans, between George Rooke of New York, and George Fryer, England, Rooke was knocked out in the first round, which lasted ene minute and ten seconds. The round began by Fryer forcing the fighting. Rooke landed a blow squarely on Eryer's mouth, Fryer then got in several half-hits, and Rooke was driven to his corner and pressed against the ropes. Fryer here sent one straight from the shoulder. The blow landed on Rooke's right arm, paralyzing it to such an extent, that he dropped his guard. Fryer then caught Rooke on the jaw, knocking him down. When Rooke picked himself up, Fryer hit him under the left jaw, and Rooke fell like a log. He was carried to his corner almost senseless, and the fight decided in favor of Fryer, who was loudly cheered.

Bernard Murphy, Champion Youth Walker of Australia, says in the Melbourne Sportsman: "On Monday previous to the match with Ormes, of Sydney, I was attacked with the 'stitch.'
