On the 15th inst., Rudolph W. Krey, of Waconia, was fishing and using Albert Burandt's boat without his authority. The latter ordered him to come ashore, and the former not complying, Burandt picked up a stone and threw it at Krey, hitting him on the head. He rode ashore and a Chaska doctor found a severe fracture of the skull. He advised trepanning immediately, but this was not done at that time. The doctor was recalled upon the patient's becoming worse and performed the operation; but Krey died immediately after. Burandt was arrested and brought before Justice Miller of Waconia, who bound him over in \$3,000 to appear before the grand jury upon the charge of murder.

The Times scribe had an interview with W. C. Parker, of Windfall, last week. Mr. Parker held a one-fifth ticket in the Louisana State Lottery, No. 59,075, which drew \$15,000, one-fifth of the first capital prize of \$75,000. E. Perry held a half interest in the ticket purchased by Mr. Parker. The two named gentlemen, in company with their attorney, R. B. Beauchamp, went to New Orleans to draw the money. When they arrived there, they had no trouble at all in procuring the \$15,000. They speak very highly of the company and say the people of New Orleans say that it is an honest, fair and reliable institution. It is recommended by the State Legislature, and that its check is good for a million dollars.—Tipton, Ind., Times, May 7.




