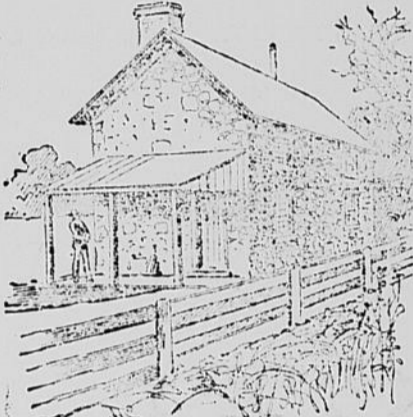


A SOLDIER'S DEATH.

MEMORABLE SCENES IN THE LIFE OF GEN. W. S. HANCOCK.

House Where He Was Born—The White Horseman of Gettysburg—The Fighting General—His Last Headquarters—Mrs. Hancock.

 NEW YORK, Feb. 16.—The early age at which so many of the generals on both sides in the late war have died is an impressive fact. Within six months of one another Grant, McClellan and Hancock have all departed from among the living. Grant was 63, McClellan was the youngest of all, being not yet 50 years old. Hancock would have been 62 if he had lived till Valentine's day. All three were men of deep chest and strong physique. In the ordinary course men of their build, having reached 50, would have continued to live till they were 70 or more. Yet they are gone. It shows how the fierce excitement and wading anxieties of the war years told on them and undermined constitutions that, in Gen. Hancock's case at least, seemed of iron. He was six feet two inches in height, and weighed at the time he was candidate for president, in 1850, 240 pounds. When a boy he was a large, strong-framed, good-tempered lad. He kept all three characteristics as long as he lived. Two, at least, of the three generals mentioned—Grant and Hancock—died of diseases that are apt to be engendered by long-continued anxiety and strain on the nervous system.



HANCOCK'S BIRTHPLACE.

Winfield Scott Hancock was born at Montgomery Square, Pa., in 1824, in the simple but picturesque house that appears in the illustration. He had a twin brother, Hilary. Soldier of his country though he was, Pennsylvania was always dearer to him than any other state of the Union. When the war of the rebellion broke out he—then Capt. Hancock—was stationed at Los Angeles, Cal. He immediately applied for a command in the Pennsylvania volunteers. It is in Pennsylvania soil that his remains rest, after his funeral in New York was ended.

Some years ago the general and his twin brother, Hilary, built a costly burial vault at Norristown. Most of the Hancock family are buried there. The general's body was laid beside that of his father. The Hancocks do not seem to be a long-lived race. The general himself has no living children. His beautiful daughter Ada, who died nine years ago, 18 years old, is buried at Norristown. The grave of his only son, Russell, who died two years ago, aged 33, is at St. Louis. There are living three grandchildren, two daughters and one son, of Russell Hancock. The way in which the general died is one of the most interesting. A snow storm of unusual severity had occasioned a visit to Gen. and Mrs. Hancock some time ago at their home on Governor's Island. The visit showed, both in the most cheerful light, the high character of a gentleman, no matter how distinguished, should always be open.



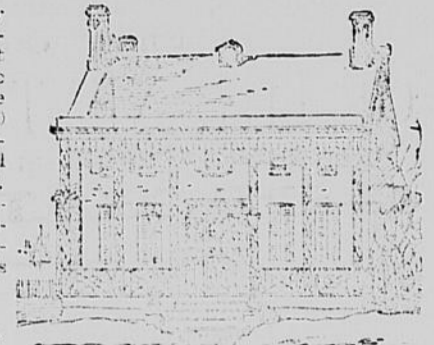
THE GETTYSBURG RIDE.

Gen. Hancock at Gettysburg is one of the historic figures of the late war, except at the storming of Petersburg in the last days of the war. The Gettysburg fight was probably the hottest fight of the rebellion. When shall we have a great American battle painter? When we do, Gen. Hancock will adorn his creations prominently. Since Washington, there has not been so superb a picturesque figure in our military history. When American battle scenes are painted, too, Hancock's famous ride at Gettysburg will be one of them. The story is a marvelous one. That battle was the turning point of victory against the south in the Confederacy. There were bloody days, July 1, 2 and 3, 1863. The second day the fighting was terrific. "Streams of shot and shell hissed everywhere," says a writer. The oldest soldier had never seen anything like that cannonading. Thousands were stricken down, the shrieks of wounded and screams of wounded men were appalling. Still the awful sound of firing missiles went on, and apparently never would cease. The Union officers began to feel uneasy about the result.

Suddenly a band began to play "The Star Spangled Banner." A thin regiment Gen. Hancock and his staff appeared on the left of the line, advanced to the front and deliberately rode down the front of the line. The line then broke. The general's horse was killed. He was thrown to the ground. He was carried to the rear and died there.

this seemed almost certain death to the general. But he escaped unharmful. He rode from end to end of the line amid the blue bullets, holding his hat in his hand, looking and smiling to his soldiers as they lay upon the ground. It was an act of splendid courage. The daring deed of their general inspired the soldiers with some of his dash and fearlessness. They fought like tigers from that moment and turned the tide of battle to victory. Hancock was mounted upon a white horse when he rode down the line that fateful day. Every eye during the hot contestward he was seen riding, his hat and thin upon his white steed, like the twin horsemen Castor and Pollux in Montaluy's "Lays of Ancient Rome."

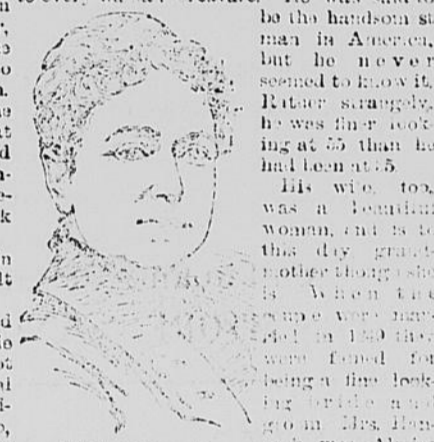
He was a great field soldier. Literally the hero of almost a hundred battles. Late in the last day at Gettysburg, after having led his men to victory, he himself was dangerously wounded. It was months before he recovered sufficiently to take the field again. He had been badly wounded once before at Frederickburg in 1862. His horse was shot under him at Chambersville and again at Ream's station in 1864. He was par excellence our fighting general.

The element of his picturesque has always entered into his life. His very surname suggests a parakeet. In March 1872 he has occupied the military division of the Atlantic, with his headquarters at Governor's Island. There is scarcely a more picturesque spot on the coast than this. Just far enough from shore to be out of hearing of the roar and rush of the city, Governor's Island nestles like a gem in the heart of New York bay. It is a favorite resort for visitors. The whole island is used by the government for military purposes. Gen. Hancock enjoyed and beautified the green island in it looked like the lawn of a wealthy private residence. The low wooden building in which the general lived, and where he died, is shown in the illustration. It was furnished in the simplest way.

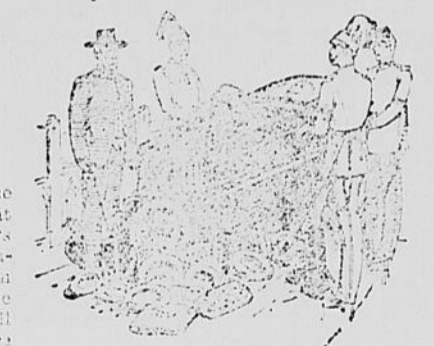
This perfect man in every way was courteous to every human creature. He was said to be the handsomest man in America, but he never seemed to know it. Rather scrupulously, he was finer looking at 55 than he had been at 15.

His wife, too, was a beautiful woman, and it is to this day gratefully remembered that she is. When the general was wounded in 1863, she was with him when he died. The last words the dying man pronounced, were his name, wife of Gen. Eugene Griggin, and his wife, Almira Russell Hancock.

It was some sort of a ceremonial day, and the general was in uniform and was busy with visitors. "I'm sorry I'm in my furs and feathers," he said to the newspaper man, "for I should have time to show you some things which might interest you." Gentle Mrs. Hancock took him into the house and showed him the portrait of her last daughter, sweet Ada Russell Hancock, who died just at the foot of the threshold of womanhood. Near the portrait hung a small piece of tapestry, the handwork of Ada. She excelled in needlework.



THE END OF ALL.

The same democratic simplicity and lack of ostentation characterized the funeral at old Trinity church, Feb. 13. He died on the 9th. No tickets of admission were required to the church. The military ceremonial of the funeral was very simple. A few of his personal friends among officers and generals, a band and an escort of artillery gave a military air to the sad rite. At his grave the major general's salute of their own guns and the salvos of artillery was fired. He was buried in a steel casket, covered with cloth, on the lid of which rested, white in church, the general's sword and hat.

THE MOST EXTENSIVE PRIVATE GAME PRESERVES ON THIS CONTINENT.

A Scheme of Pierre Lorillard's—Why He Leaves the Turf—His Feeling for the Workingman—Picturesque Sketches by a Special Artist.

 New York, Feb. 16.—Many recent incidents have served to bring the name of Pierre Lorillard before the public. He has endeavored to live a quiet, unassuming life, only his intimate friends and the thousands in his employ being aware of his kindness of his paternal heart to ameliorate the condition of those whom fortune has not favored as he himself. The announcement of his retirement from the turf, to the development of which he devoted \$250,000 a year, was promulgated solely by his self-respect. He has been for years opposing the tenancy which reduced the American turf from honest contests of horse racing and training to gambling dens. Failing in his attempt to banish it, he has determined to withdraw, making with him much of the old time responsibility of the turf.

Mr. Lorillard is to go to a work among the workingmen of the turf, and will be a remarkable success in his way, and throws a little light on the character of the man. The following are a few extracts:



ENTRANCE GATE AND LODGE.

DEAR MR. YOUNG: You will not be surprised to find that I do not usually answer letters personally, as I have so much to do, but I have at present had up in my mind an accident which I would like to mention to you. I would like to see you at 10 o'clock on Monday next, at the office of the New York Herald. I have a few things to say to you, and I am sure you will find them of interest.

But the best of all is that my own affairs. I have the pleasure of giving the masses and especially the poor a few good things for existence. Could not their fathers have done to look upon the old as the most efficient instrumentality to prepare for them a more satisfactory state of affairs. Communism is and always has been a failure. Co-operative work is well in theory, but has generally failed; and yet I think we must look to them in the near future as the most practicable method of benefiting the laboring classes.

The danger to the people by the accumulation of the enormous fortunes of the present day, and the fact of their being owned by persons who seem to have no respect, love or common feeling for the people, seems to me a great and important problem. In Europe princes, dukes and persons of great wealth use their means in a liberal and wise way for the gratification, happiness and refinement of the people around them, whereas in this country they are selfishly and they are, or appear to be, utterly indifferent to the suffering at their doors. As to your hint of an expanding rising among the people, personally I have nothing to fear. Against all my means are in my factories, and I will always be in the front rank of those who love the people and shall do all in my power to check them in any madness that bad or ambitious leaders may advocate.

An inquiry among the hands of his tenants in the ones corroborates his assertion of endeavor to elevate his working people, as far as it is in his power, with a good discipline. Mr. Lorillard lives very plainly; it would be hard to wager that no \$15-a-week dry goods clerk in New York city does more for all.

But it is to the development of Tuxedo park, of which so much has been said lately, that Mr. Lorillard's name is now most frequently mentioned. Tuxedo park is situated in the northwestern part of New York city. It comprises 600 acres of the most charming and picturesque scenery imaginable, diversified by streams which meander down among the rough borders of the Ramapo mountains, to form the Ramapo river and its tributaries. Mr. Lorillard's intention was to make this lake with fish, and it has become the most celebrated in the region. It is Mr. Lorillard's idea to stock the other ponds and woods with fish and game of every kind, after the style of the great parks of Europe. A handsome mansion is engaged to direct the whole work of laying out roads and bridge paths with a view of retaining all the wild beauties of nature.

Buildings and out-goes are being constructed like that of the lodge at the entrance. Some of the from the hillside, without the slightest dressing is used, care being taken that all the clinging moss is retained, giving them in appearance all the wildness and richness of nature, though they are the creations of today. Besides the old road built by the Continental army, which is still in a good state of preservation,

Now, there is no hope that will be carefully preserved; it is the ruins of the old force in which the immense iron chain was fastened that was drawn across the Hudson in revolutionary times to prevent English ships from proceeding further. The estate of Mr. Lorillard is a good type of those being built throughout the park by rich members of the Tuxedo club. This club, of which Mr. Lorillard is president and principal shareholder, sells to its members building sites, and for those who do not care to become residents a club house is about completed, with 100 bedrooms and every comfort of a first-class hotel. As the chief purpose of this association is the preservation of the health of its members, every possible variety of outdoor amusement is provided, both for summer and winter. To retain the game with in the park the whole is surrounded by a high wall, eight feet high, four feet of which from the ground up is cut and do not grow. In the opinion of this colony of sportsmen, should it prove successful it will show the power of many similar efforts of wealthy families to live in communities where they can protect themselves from disagreeable surroundings.

The New American Cardinal.

The second citizen of the United States who has been raised to the ecclesiastical dignity of a membership in the college of cardinals is Archbishop Gibbons of Baltimore. The college of cardinals corresponds to our electoral college, as its chief purpose is to elect the pope or president of the church. The cardinals, whose number is about sixty, are chosen by the living pope in order that they may elect his successor. Archbishop Gibbons is 52 years of age and a native of Baltimore. He began his career as a clerk in New Orleans. His vocation appearing to be toward the ministry he began a long series of studies and was ordained a priest. He was connected for many years with several Baltimore churches; took an important part in the deliberations of the Plenary Council of Baltimore in 1846, and presented at the following council held in 1850 and 1855 in the same city. He was sent to labor in North Carolina in 1858, and was so an ardent and successful bishop. In 1877 he was consecrated cardinal and bishop of Baltimore and upon the death of a cardinal succeeded him. He has been a conspicuous promoter by investigation the north and by hard work he has stepped slowly from the place of a humble priest to the next to the highest honor in his church. Among Baltimore citizens of every creed he is distinguished for his humanity, piety and broad Christian views.
